**LESSON 1: Stone Age match up cards**

**PERIOD**

Paleolithic  
(Old Stone Age)

**FEATURES**

Different kinds of early humans moving from place to place to hunt with basic stone tools.

**PERIOD**

Mesolithic  
(Middle Stone Age)

**FEATURES**

Humans starting to settle down more with slightly more advanced tools to live together in groups called communities.

**PERIOD**

Neolithic  
(New Stone Age)

**FEATURES**

Humans becoming more organised by farming, keeping animals and settling in much larger groups with advanced tools.

**PERIOD**

Bronze Age

**FEATURES**

A metal made from tin and copper changes the world, providing sharper metal tools to help grow cities, hunt better and defend land.

**PERIOD**

Iron Age

**FEATURES**

A new metal that is stronger and easier to make is discovered, which allows much better items such as weapons and tools to be made.
